Calaveras Connect is encouraging all passengers on Calaveras Connect vehicles, and those visiting Calaveras Connect facilities, to wear a face mask covering nose and mouth. The CDC recommends that anyone leaving their homes should use face coverings to limit their potential exposure to the COVID-19 novel coronavirus and to prevent exposing others. Bus operators and all essential Calaveras Connect staff are encouraged to wear a face mask covering the nose and mouth as well.

Other measures Calaveras Connect has taken to limit bus operator and passenger exposure to the coronavirus are:

- Cleaning buses daily, in between routes when possible, with strong disinfectants.
- Strongly encouraging passengers to keep six-feet away from the bus operator and other passengers (social distancing).

Calaveras Connect asks passengers to follow health guidelines provided by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipes.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after using the restroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.
